Are you interested in getting your start in politics and making a difference in the State of Washington? There is no better place than a legislative campaign. The House Democratic Campaign Committee (HDCC) is seeking motivated, detailed, team-oriented fellows to help support and defend the Democratic majority in the state House of Representatives. No previous campaign or political experience required.

Campaign Fellows will assist the HDCC staff on day-to-day support on competitive races in many parts of the state, and there are opportunities to focus on the following campaign skills: field, data management, volunteer recruitment, research and potentially more depending on campaign needs. Fellows may be responsible for one of the following, though it will vary from campaign to campaign.

Responsibilities:

- Assist the political department with field operations, such as knocking doors, calling voters, recruiting and training volunteers, and traveling to districts to reach voters.
- Assist with research and Canva assignments.
- When needed, staff campaign fundraisers, community events, and forums.
- Assist the finance department.
- Grow skills and experience with Votebuilder/VAN, proficiency with Google Sheets or Excel and design platforms such as Canva or PowerPoint
- Other responsibilities as assigned.

Qualifications:

- Interest and passion for electing Democrats to the State House.
- Strong research, written, and verbal communication skills.
- Comfortable participating in traditional forms of voter contact, including canvassing and phone-banking.
- A desire to grow within the work of campaigns and possible job advancement opportunities
- Capacity to work flexible hours including evenings and weekends.
