Job Description

Field Organizers will coordinate and oversee all aspects of the campaign's field operations.

Responsibilities:

- Assist with the execution of the field plan in coordination with the campaign manager, candidate, and HDCC. Make adjustments to field operations as necessary throughout the campaign cycle
- Execute the field plan including direct voter contact, canvassing, public relations, and volunteer management
- Demonstrates commitment to the district through daily in-person communication with local district volunteers, leaders, and campaign staff
- Follow metric-based goals possibly including, but not limited to: phone calls, doors knocked, texts, and volunteer shifts
- Recruit, manage, and train volunteers while providing a high-quality volunteer experience

Qualifications:

- 1+ campaign cycles (volunteering or campaign internships count)
- Access to a vehicle and a valid driver's License
- Knowledge and familiarity with NGP/VAN platform is highly desired.
- Self-motivated and strategic, with experience handling multiple priorities and maintaining attention to detail in a high-stakes, deadline-driven environment
